Privacy

At Asmarina, we intend to give you as much control as possible over your personal information. In general, you can visit Asmarina sites without telling us who you are or revealing any information about yourself or your organisation. There are times, however, when we may need information from you, such as your name, address, and contact numbers to process your order and delivery. It is our intent to inform you before collecting personal information from you on the Internet.

In order to provide you with goods and services and maintain our high standards in our professional dealings, Asmarina will inform you of what information is required from you before we can go ahead with your enquiries and orders. If you refuse to supply this information, we may not be able to respond to your requests.

If you choose to give us personal information via the Internet that we or our business partners may need (e.g., to correspond with you, process an order and delivery), it is our intent to let you know how we will use such information. If you tell us that you do not wish to have this information used as a basis for further contact with you, we will respect your wishes. We do keep track of the domains from which people visit us. We analyse this data for trends and statistics, and then we discard it.

Cookies

There is a technology called "cookies" which can be used to provide you with tailored information from a web site.
